Sock-it-to-'em

Please help provide men and women with basic items like socks as they enter our recovery program. Ask your group for donations of new socks for men and women.



Undie Sunday/Monday

The homeless and addicted constantly need personal items like underwear. Please help provide them with these bare necessities by holding this fun drive at church on Sunday or at the office on Monday. Simply ask for donations of new T-shirts and underwear for men and women.



Back 2 School

You can give children from low-income families the opportunity to go back to school with all the supplies they need with our Back 2 School drive. Collect items like new backpacks, pencils, notebooks, crayons, glue and other supplies these kids will need to succeed in school.



Food for the Soul

In addition to providing three meals a day to residents in long-term recovery, The Foundry distributes food boxes to low-income families in the community. Please help us by organizing a food drive within your organization. Food Drive Kits with a list of items needed are available to assist in your collection.
